The recipient will be asked to provide a final letter to the Company upon course completion outlining their progress. If for any reason there is a refund of tuition due to the discontinuation of studies, the portion funded by ConocoPhillips must be returned to the Company. Please note that the bursary is awarded on a one-year basis, and there is no commitment by ConocoPhillips Canada to provide funding for future years.
